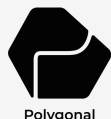

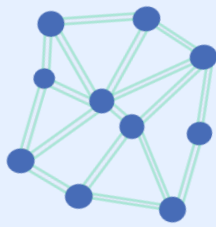
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What is eMATES?



The eMATES project aims to bridge the digital divide for adult migrants by supporting second-language (L2) educators.

It provides educators with innovative methods and educational resources to help them effectively teach language skills in the context of e-government.

By enhancing language proficiency (A1, A2, B1 levels) and promoting the use of digital tools, the project fosters greater autonomy and social inclusion for migrants.

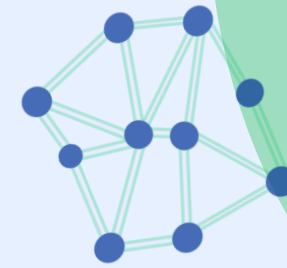
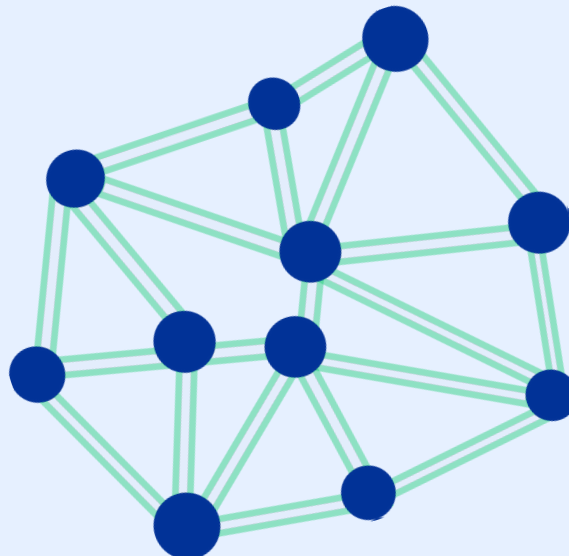
Strengthen the ability of L2 educators to teach digital and e-government-related content.
